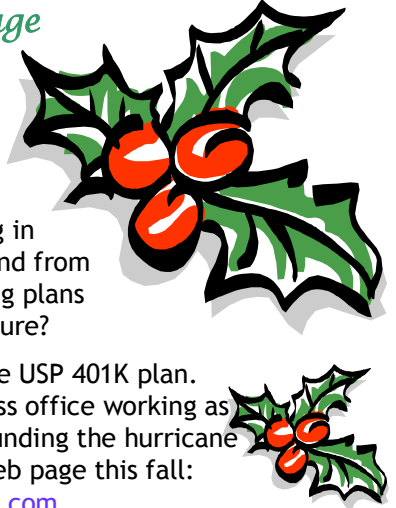
- Robert **designs his first commercial web site.**
